**August 20, 2024 Special Election Charter Amendment Ballot Question:**

**Voting requirements to issue bonds or borrow money**

The Charter requires four votes of the City Commission to issue bonds or borrow money, and five votes if such indebtedness exceeds five percent of the City's operating budget. This Charter amendment would amend the Charter to require three votes of the Commission where debt is subject to a voter referendum at a General Election, and four votes where debt is not subject to voter approval.
