Title of Proposed Ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SOUTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, COMPREHENSIVELY AMENDING ARTICLE III, "NOISE," OF CHAPTER 15, "OFFENSES AND MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS," OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES TO REVISE THE NOISE REGULATIONS WITHIN THE CITY; REPEALING OUTDATED PROVISIONS IN SECTIONS 15-83 THROUGH 15-92, SECTION 15-94, SECTION 15-95, AND SECTIONS 15-97 THROUGH 15-99; AND DELETING SECTION 15-100, "GRAFFITI AND GRAFFITI REMOVAL AREAS" FROM ARTICLE III "NOISE" AND AMENDING ARTICLE I "IN GENERAL" TO RELOCATE THE PROVISION AS SECTION 15-2; PROVIDING FOR CORRECTIONS; SEVERABILITY; CONFLICTS; IMPLEMENTATION; AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Summary of Proposed Ordinance and Statement of Public Purpose to be Served:

The proposed ordinance would amend the City's code Section 15-82

The proposed ordinance furthers public health, safety, and welfare by ensuring noise levels are controlled and appropriately regulated. These provisions aim to strike a balance between the everyday activities of residents and businesses and the need to maintain a peaceful environment and are similar to the limits set in neighboring communities

Estimate of Direct Economic Impact on Private/For Profit Businesses:

a. Estimate of Direct Business Compliance Costs:

The proposed ordinance does not require businesses to take on additional costs.

b. New Charges/Fees on Businesses Impacted:

The proposed ordinance does not impose a new fee or charge for which businesses will be financially responsible.

The proposed ordinance changes present an initial investment of approximately \$2,000 to purchase the sound readers.

to, any Federal, State, local, or private grant, or other financial assistance accepted by the municipal government.

- The proposed ordinance is an emergency ordinance.
- The proposed ordinance relates to procurement.

 - Development orders and development permits, as those terms are defined in s. 163.3164, and development agreements, as authorized by the Florida Local Government Development Agreement Act under ss. 163.3220-163.3243;
 - Comprehensive plan amendments and land development regulation amendments initiated by an application by a private party other than the municipality;
 - Sections 190.005 and 190.046, Florida Statutes, regarding community development districts;
 - Section 553.73, Florida Statutes, relating to the Florida Building Code; or
 - Section 633.202, Florida Statutes, relating to the Florida Fire Prevention Code
