Entrance Requirements

1. Children under seven (7) years of age must be accompanied by a parent or a competent person at least 16 years of age who is appropriately in a swimsuit. This person must remain with the child at **all times**.
2. Admissions may be denied for the following reasons:
 - a) A person appears to be unable to care for him/herself.
 - b) A person is intoxicated or impaired by drugs.
 - c) A person refuses to present ID as proof of residential rates.
 - d) There are open sores, wounds, or running of the nose.
 - e) The swimmer is wearing excessively brief or revealing swimwear or is otherwise wearing clothing inappropriate for swimming, i.e. cut-offs, shorts, t-shirts; ALL swimmers must wear a swimsuit with a liner.
 - f) Any other conditions that in the opinion of the Supervisor will jeopardize the health and safety of the general public.
3. All swimmers must take showers before entering the pool.
4. During daily operation every person seeking admittance must pay the regular admission fee or present a valid pass.
5. Weapons, knives, or concealed handguns are strictly forbidden in the pool area.
6. Participants will not enter the pool deck area until the Lifeguards are on duty.
7. The City of South Miami is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Pool Rules

1. Always follow the instructions of a lifeguard.
2. No running in or around the pool. Please walk on the pool deck and in locker rooms.
3. Proper swim attire is required to use pool.
4. Keep off lane ropes and safety lines.
5. No horseplay in or around the pool. Patrons may not ride on the shoulders of another patron, engage in rough play, dunking, splashing, water fighting or pushing.
6. Abusive or profane language or behavior is prohibited.
7. Playing or hanging on the ladders is forbidden.
8. Please do not distract lifeguards in elevated stands.



9. No diving allowed.
10. Do not swallow pool water.
11. Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose, urinating or defecating in the pool is strictly prohibited.
12. For your safety, no extended breath holding exercises are allowed.
13. No pets allowed.
14. No food or chewing gum permitted in or around the pool.
15. Water in plastic containers are the only permitted beverage in the pool area.
16. No smoking, dipping, or chewing is allowed in the pool area.

Splash Pad Rules

1. The splash pad is not under Lifeguard supervision. Use at your own risk.
2. Children must have adult supervision at all times.
3. Slip resistant shoes are recommended at all times for guests on the splash pad.
4. Illness and injury must be reported to a lifeguard immediately.
5. Children who are not toilet trained must wear swim diapers (regular diaper changing should occur).
6. Persons with infectious diseases or open sores shall not use the splash pad.
7. No illegal, disruptive, destructive or inappropriate behavior is allowed.
8. The following activities are not permitted in the splash pad area:
 - a. Climbing, sitting and playing on any pad apparatus.
 - b. Drinking splash pad water, spitting and spouting of water from mouth.
 - c. Running, tough play, and profanity.
 - d. Inflatable toys, strollers, bicycles, scooters, skateboards, pool toys, athletic and other recreation equipment (except wheelchairs or other assistance approved devices)
 - e. Food, gum, candy or beverages.
 - f. Soaps, detergents and shampoos.
 - g. Any animal or reptile.
 - h. Changing diapers.
 - i. Radios and other acoustical devices.
 - j. Smoking.
9. Proper swim attire is required.
10. Splash pad is under video surveillance and is regularly monitored.

Splash pad may be closed at any time due to weather, maintenance or other operational concerns.
